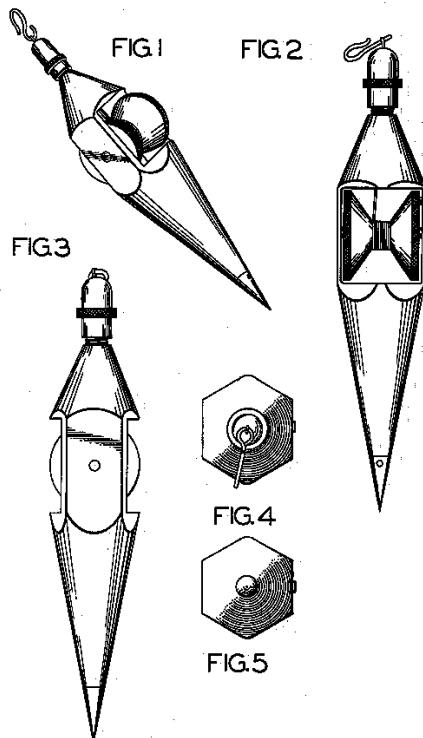


FIGURE 1 is a perspective view of a plumb bob, showing my new design;

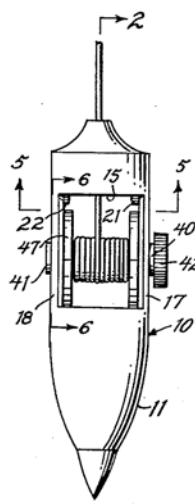

Recently I bought one, so I can give you some detailed information and pictures:

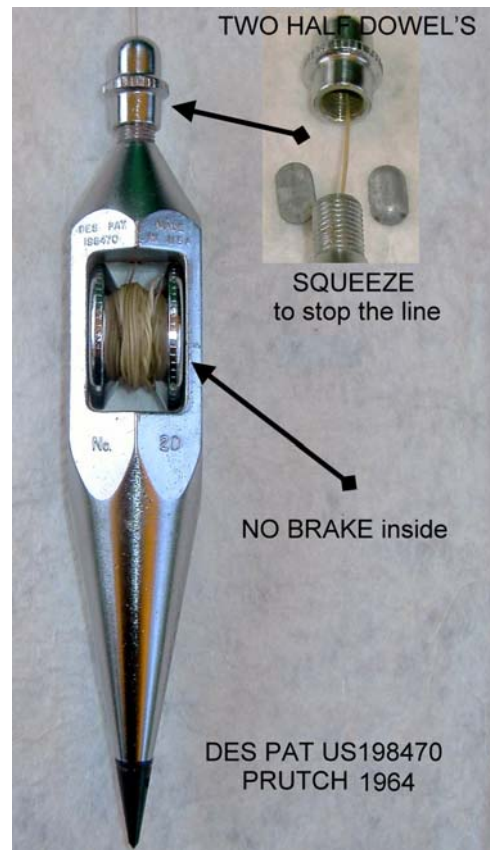
This plumb bob is also sold as "SPEED BOB", nickel plated and it is very long (8 inch / 20 cm).



When I picked up the plumb bob at the customs I directly checked if the part 6 "TWO HALF DOWEL'S to keep the line from slipping" were still there, because I could not find a BRAKE on the wheel like the STANLEY 1874.

They were inside! 😊

It is marked: DES PAT 198470 MADE IN USA No 20

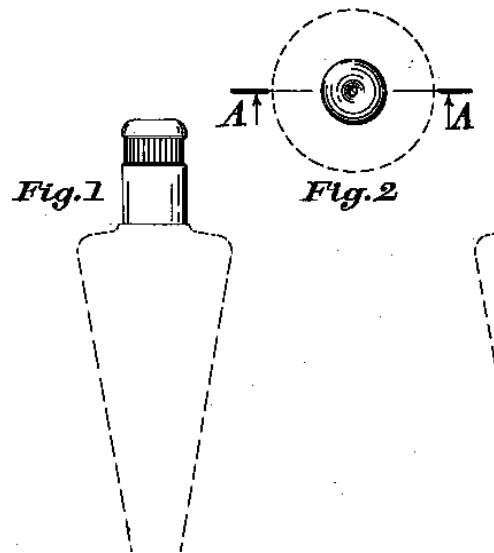
